

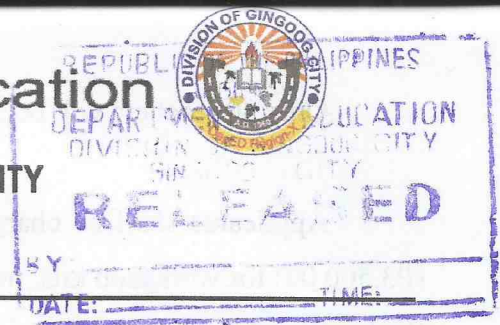

2019 CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY

The **Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP)**, through its Arts Education Department, will conduct a series of workshops under the **2019 CCP Summer Arts Academy**, for teachers of Senior High School (SHS) Arts and Design Track, SHS's Core Subjects with Humanities and Arts related competencies and the Special Program of the Arts (SPA) from **April 29 to May 4, 2019** at the CCP and from **May 6 to 10, 2019** at the Siliman University, Dumaguete City.

This Arts Academy is especially designed to provide teachers (non-beginners) the avenue to grow and develop their craft in line with arts. However, preference will be given to teacher-applicants who has active engagement with creative and artistic productions, attending major festivals or those who are actively engaged in mentoring/coaching students in the arts for competitions and other national and international competitions/exhibitions in the different fields of arts.

The workshop modules include the following:

- April 29-May 3, 2019 at Cultural Center of the Philippines
 - Culture-based Choreography for Street Dance Festival
 - Intensive Workshop for Dance Teachers
 - Costume Design for Street Dance Festival
 - Film Script Writing
 - Mixed Media
 - Rehearsal and Performance Technique
 - Stage Management
 - Managing Your Arts Event
- May 6 to 10, 2019 at Siliman University, Dumaguete City
 - Children's Choral Workshop
 - Music Therapy

Only 30 teachers will be accepted per module.

Applicants shall be charged a registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00) for workshop kits, training laboratory and materials for the duration of the workshop. Such registration, transportation, board and lodging, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations as per DepEd Memorandum No. 10, s. 2019.
