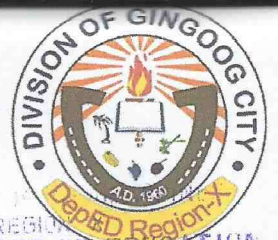

Re : **ADMINISTRATION OF THE 2018 ACCREDITATION and
EQUIVALENCY (A&E) TEST**

1. This is to announce that the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), shall administer the **2018 ACCREDITATION and EQUIVALENCY (A&E) TEST** on **March 3, 2019**.
2. Pursuant to DepEd Order 55, s. 2016 entitled Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the following may take the A&E Test:
 - a. Learners in the Alternative Learning system (ALS) and Nonformal Education Programs;
 - b. Out-of-school children and youth who are prepared for assessment; and
 - c. Adults who are seeking Certification of Learning.
3. Applicants shall be at least 12 years old for the A&E elementary level and at least 16 years old for the A&E Junior High School level on the examination day.
4. Only the registered applicants with complete requirements shall be allowed to take the A&E Test at the testing centers approved by BEA on March 3, 2019.
5. Only testing personnel and test monitors approved by DepEd officials are allowed on the testing center premises during the examination day.
6. Room examiners/proctors shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. Testing personnel and test monitors who render services during the conduct of the activity which may fall on weekends and holidays are entitled to avail of Compensatory Time Off (CTO) in accordance with Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 1, s. 2015 (3.2 and 4.8) entitled Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees.
