### NOMINATION OF PARTICIPANTS TO THE CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING-SECONDARY (CELT-S) PROGRAM OF SEAMEO RELC

The Southeast Asian Minister of Education Organization – Regional Language Center (SEAMEO RELC) is offering the SEAMEO RELC scholarship for the 2019 Certificate in English Language Teaching-Secondary (CELT-S) Program, which will run from July 22, 2019 to February 27, 2020.

This program is designed by Cambridge Assessment English (CAE) for in-service teachers of English working in secondary school setting.

SEAMEO will cover the registration and tuition fees for the entire program, as well as the subsistence allowance, airfare and accommodation cost for the period of residential stay at RELC. The other details of the program are enclosed in the Terms and Conditions of Program Participation.

Teacher-applicants should submit their documents to the SGOD-HRD unit, with the endorsement from their school head.

The program allocates four (4) slots for the Philippines with the following qualifications and the corresponding documentary requirements:

- Filipino citizens
- Not more than 50 years old
- At least 2 years of full-time English language teaching experience or experience in English language/curriculum planning and language development program
- Must have no pending administrative and/or criminal case
- Medically fit as certified by a licensed physician
- Able to understand, speak and write in English

- Able to utilize course learning as well as share them with other school heads upon return to their work station
- Computer literate and have access to Internet connection to enable them to participate in online interactions.

The Division Office will accept application until **April 10, 2019**.
